



GENZYME CORPORATION BIOTECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP

As a member of the Allston-Brighton community, Genzyme Corporation has established community outreach programs to benefit the residents of Allston-Brighton. Under the auspices of the outreach program, Genzyme has established a scholarship fund to provide financial assistance to students seeking higher education in the Life Sciences. Scholarship amounts will begin at a minimum of \$1,000.

Eligibility information for applicants:

1. You must have been a resident of Allston or Brighton for the past three years. The three-year residency requirement will be counted as the three-year period ending June 2009.
2. You may be a student at any public, private or parochial secondary school; or if you have previously received a Genzyme scholarship, you may be a student at any college or university.
3. You must be accepted into an accredited college or university and designate a major in a life science* or life science-related field.
**Life Science includes: biology, chemistry, microbiology, pre-med, nursing, pharmacy, health sciences, physical therapy, nutrition, chemical engineering, etc.*
4. Your overall academic record must be a 'B' (3.0) or above.

Application and Selection Process:

1. All eligible students must complete the attached application and submit it with required documents.
2. Completed application packages should be returned **no later than April 1, 2009 to Genzyme Corporation, Attn: Scholarship Program/Community Relations, 500 Kendall Street, Cambridge MA 02142**. Complete packages include the completed application form, Section II-Academic Transcripts/SAT Scores, Section III-Essay, Section IV-Listing of Extra-curricular Activities, and Section V-Two Letters of Recommendation.
3. Application packages must be sent to Genzyme Corporation by April 1, 2009. Those received after this date will not be considered.
4. A Selection Committee comprised of Genzyme Senior Vice Presidents, the Scholarship Program Director, and two representatives of the Allston-Brighton community will select the recipients of the scholarship awards.
5. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the Selection Committee and will be based upon academic performance, essay, and demonstrated interest in the field of life sciences. The total number and respective amounts of the scholarships to be granted will vary annually and will be determined by the number of qualified applicants. Scholarship amounts will range from \$1,000 to \$3,500 each.
6. Students will be notified of the results the week of May 15, 2009.
